



KET Political Coverage and Candidate Invitation Criteria

2020 Primary Elections for United States House of Representatives

KET may cover the 2020 primary elections for U.S. House of Representatives on its public affairs programs based on its good faith journalistic judgment as to what will best serve the interests of its viewers. If, as part of its coverage, KET determines to host a program or programs featuring candidates in the 2020 U.S. House of Representatives primary elections, candidates will be invited to participate if they satisfy **all** of the following criteria:

1. The candidate has qualified for a place on the primary election ballot as determined by the Kentucky Secretary of State.
2. By April 15, 2020, the candidate or the candidate's principal campaign committee has a publicly accessible website or social media account related to the campaign that contains public policy statements.
3. The candidate's principal campaign committee must have reported net contributions of at least twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000), or reported net expenditures of at least twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000), on the April 15, 2020 Quarterly Report it files with the Federal Election Commission ("FEC") using FEC Form 3. KET will determine satisfaction of this criterion using the amounts listed on line 6(c), Column B (Election Cycle-to-Date), and line 7(c), Column B (Election Cycle-to-Date) of the Summary Page of Receipts and Disbursements, of FEC Form 3, shown circled on the following page. To satisfy this criterion, at least one of these two reported amounts, by itself, must be \$25,000 or more. This criterion cannot be satisfied by adding the two amounts together. KET will not consider any FEC Form 3 filed or amended after the April 15, 2020 filing deadline.

Participation in KET's public affairs programs is contingent upon satisfaction of these criteria.

Notwithstanding its having invited a candidate or candidates to appear, KET reserves the right not to cover particular political races and the right to cancel any scheduled program.
