Then, *Kentucky Life* goes into its archives for a memory segment when host Doug Flynn recounts his visit to Idlewild.

And lastly, *Kentucky Life* checks out the state's sneakerheads, those young and old who collect, sell, and customize their favorites shoes. It's a growing field, one that's created a culture all its own.
