

## Marvin Young Photographer

Marvin Young is the Visual and Member Communications Coordinator for the National Council of Teachers of English, a position attained after serving the organization for three years as a freelance photographer.

As a state photographer for the Commonwealth of Kentucky for nearly 10 years, Young was responsible for documenting Governor Steve Beshear and Governor Matt Bevin for media outreach and historical purposes. This position also included covering government events, making official portraits to meet the visual needs of several state agencies such as the Supreme Court, capturing images used to promote the vast state park system, and vital images used to document the major campaign for its revitalization.

Young also worked as a multimedia specialist and photographer for the National Center for Families Learning and held a similar position at the University of Louisville Office of News and Public Information.

Young has been a photojournalist for the Louisville Defender Newspaper and Director of Photography for the Louisville Cardinal Newspaper.

Young has been an Official Derby Festival Photographer for nearly 25 years.
